## CYCLE & CARRIAGE, KECHARA LIGHTEN THE LOAD OF POOR FAMILIES AND THE HOMELESS

RM15,000 and Provisions for Poor Families, and Warm Meals for the Homeless

**Petaling Jaya, 11 January 2018** – 'He Ain't Heavy, He's My Brother'. The famous lyrics to the hit song by The Hollies aptly describe the sentiments of Cycle & Carriage Bintang Berhad (Cycle & Carriage Bintang) and Kechara Soup Kitchen (Kechara) volunteers during its Food Bank Delivery outreach. The initiative, held during the festive season, was aimed at reducing the burden of families living in poverty and bringing cheer to the homeless around the Klang Valley, Johor Bahru and Penang.

Over 40 Cycle & Carriage Bintang employees reached out to 30 low income families around the Klang Valley and Johor Bahru delivering care packages containing essential food provisions including rice, cooking oil, oats and biscuits. The employees also spent time with the families lending a sympathetic ear in an effort to better understand their plight. Information on the families' condition, health issues and any other needs would assist Kechara to gain further insights and enable them to provide assistance in the future.

Up north in Penang, Cycle & Carriage Bintang employees spent the holidays at the Kechara Soup Kitchen Centre packing and distributing warm meals which benefitted about 120 homeless individuals.

Moved by the whole experience, Cycle & Carriage Bintang went the extra mile to donate a cash sum of RM15,000 in financial aid complemented by food provisions and basic household items valued at RM4,850 to help Kechara continue its impactful outreach efforts.
